

In-Class Element Project

Students you will research an element and present it to the class!

Guidelines:

(Teacher will provide 1 sheet of 8.5" X 11" white computer paper for your groups presentation. This should be used to highlight your findings.)

You MUST do #1. You must also choose any other 8 items to put on your poster. In the end you will have a total of 9 guidelines on your poster about your element.

1. Draw a picture to show the arrangement of Protons, Neutrons, and Electrons within the atom, add color.
2. The number of Protons
3. The number of Neutrons
4. The number of Electrons
5. Location on the Periodic Table
6. 3 Facts about your element
7. Uses
8. Poem about your element
9. Paragraph on the history of your element
10. Clay model of your element (See the teacher for clay)

All students will then present their findings to the class in a 3-minute presentation.
